street and slum children. Cur-
rently, we are feeding 200
children a good breakfast daily
seven days a week and encourag-
ing them to attend schools.
Winter jackets, clothings and
school supplies are provided to
them as needed.

At this time we are short of
\$ 1750 each month to fully meet
our commitments of the feeding
programme.
